



Appendix B Agent Contact Policy

Agents registered and approved by the WVU Athletic Compliance Office are eligible to meet with WVU student-athletes (*ref. WVU Football Agent Policy Section I-B*) per the following guidelines:

- A. Football student-athletes are permitted to meet with approved agents beginning May 1 following completion of their junior season of eligibility.
- B. Agents must be registered and approved by the WVU Athletic Compliance Office in order to be eligible to engage in a meeting with our student-athlete(s).
- C. All requests for a meeting must be directed to WVU's Director of Football Operations. Please note that student-athletes will not be permitted to miss class in order to meet with an agent. Therefore, reasonable notice should be given to the meeting request.
- D. All meetings must take place at the Milan Puskar Center.
- E. Student-athletes reserve the right to refuse any meeting(s) at any time(s) for any reason(s).
- F. Student-athletes reserve the option of allowing their parent/guardian to participate in the meeting in-person or via conference call.
- G. WVU's Director of Football Operations (or other designated staff member as approved by the Athletic Compliance Office) will accompany the student-athlete during the meeting. It is not permissible for a student-athlete to meet with an agent without a staff member present.
- H. All communication and/or activities must adhere to state, federal, NCAA, Conference, and University rules and regulations.
